How to obtain Graduate Housing for Summer 2024

- Current students should complete the [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) by April 28, 2024. Those who do not will be required to vacate their spring assignment by May 5, 2024.

- Space is limited, and assignments are **NOT** guaranteed.

Summer Rates and Details:

University Village



- \$3302 for standard capacity (two students per one-bedroom unit and four students per two-bedroom unit).
- \$4953 for private bedroom capacity (no roommates assigned to the bedroom; you may have others assigned with you in a second bedroom).
- We will continue to offer a 50% discount for summer housing for students who are assigned for the entire summer (\$1651 for standard and \$2476.50 for private bedrooms).

Private Bedroom Notes

- Private rooms are not guaranteed and are determined by availability.
- As private rooms fluctuate from year to year, the standard two sets of bedroom furniture remain in the room.

Utilities are Included!

- Students do not have to set up, close, and coordinate payment of utilities services (electricity, gas, and trash).
- The cost for utilities is included in the housing rate on your APU bill.

Financial Aid

- Graduate students who are assigned campus housing and who receive financial aid are subject to award revisions. Please reach out to your Student Account Specialist for more information.

Eligibility

Open to graduate students currently living in graduate housing and new graduate students seeking housing. Students need to be **enrolled** in graduate-level academic programs in-person on the Azusa Campus (at least one class per traditional academic semester). New graduate students must be enrolled during the summer at the start of their residency. Continuing students extending for summer do not need to be enrolled for the summer if they are enrolled for the fall. This program is not for students who are required to be in person for a few weeks in the summer. Those students should connect with their academic program regarding housing options. APU does not currently offer housing for married students, families, or current faculty and staff members.

Placement and Dates of Term

Summer Graduate Housing will be located in University Village (P, Q, and S). The summer term and check-in will be Tuesday, May 7, 2024 from 12-5pm. The 13 weeks of summer housing officially ends on August 2, 2024 for those who have not secured fall 2024 graduate housing, regardless of when summer programs or classes end. **This date is not flexible.**

How to Apply

New and continuing students who need housing for summer 2024 must submit the [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) by April 28, 2024. Those currently living in graduate housing who do not request a summer extension must checkout and vacate their spring assignment by May 5, 2024.

Benefits and Amenities

- Close to campus; Apartment living
- Unit includes: Washer/dryer, refrigerator, stove/oven, over the range microwave, dishwasher, twin XL bed, dresser, desk, chair
- Live with fellow APU graduate students (two students per one-bedroom unit and four students per two-bedroom unit)
- Private-bedroom occupancy available if/as enrollment allows
- Access to campus amenities (APU wireless internet access, dining venues, fitness center, recreational areas, libraries, etc.)

Assignment or Wait List Notifications

Summer assignment or wait list notifications will be emailed out on the evening of **April 30, 2024**. Assignments made after this date will be emailed as they are made (usually within 48-72 hours). As space is limited, we cannot guarantee assignments and always recommend that students look off campus as well.

Commitment

Students who submit a [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) make a commitment for the entire 13 weeks of summer housing when they check-in and receive their room key. There is no weekly option for graduate housing.

Summer Housing Reminders

Summer Check-in

Grad students who are not already living in their unit from the spring semester, may check into their Summer Housing space beginning **Tuesday, May 7, 2024 at 12pm** at the Residence Life service window in Engstrom Hall. Residence Life will be open until 5pm.

Moving from one unit to another?

If you are transitioning from an existing spring unit to a new summer unit, the general checkout deadline of May 5, 2024 at 3pm does not apply to you. All summer residents must be out of their spring unit by 10pm on Tuesday May 7, 2024. You will not be homeless for a day! Please be prepared for your move. Be packed, cleaned, and ready!

Getting units ready

As the transition from spring to summer is very tight, Facilities Management will use Sunday and Monday to prepare units for move-in on Tuesday. We will not be able to check you in on Sunday or Monday. Residents will have until Tuesday at 10pm to be checked out of their spring assignment (if applicable). Please use Sunday and Monday to pack and clean so that your transition on Tuesday will be smooth. If there are any concerns during your move, please find your new summer RA or GRC so they can assist.

Basic Utilities

The cost of utilities is covered in the housing rates. Students do not need to set up, coordinate payments, or close down service. This includes electricity, gas, water, trash, and sewage.

Frontier Internet

Internet in the Village is provided by Frontier Communications in coordination with the university. If there are issues with the internet when you move into your apartment, please find the router, and press the reset button. After resetting the router, use the Wi-Fi password printed on the router to connect. If you are missing equipment or have difficulties connecting, please contact the support desk at (626) 815-5050 or support@apu.edu. When you move out of the apartment, please leave all of the equipment in the unit and plugged in. Students who remove equipment will be charged for the replacement as part of the checkout process.

Summer Work Projects – Wood Balconies and Stairwells

There are always work projects going on during the summer. These projects are essential in the general upkeep of the living areas. At times, these projects may cause some inconvenience. This summer, there will be significant repairs to wood balconies and stairwells throughout the Village. Facilities Management will be in contact with any summer residents when repairs may impact them specifically. Thanks for your patience as we continue to improve the campus.

Parking

Summer parking is coordinated through Campus Safety (permits and gate remotes). After you have been assigned to summer housing, please contact Campus Safety to obtain parking.

Maintenance and furniture requests may be submitted online via your home.apu.edu portal. Please note, extra furniture will not be removed, even if students are not assigned to a space or there is a private bedroom.

End of Summer Checkout

If you are staying until the end of summer and are a fall resident, you will most likely just remain in your unit for the fall as well. However, if you happen to have a different assignment for fall, you will check out of your summer unit and into your fall unit on August 2, 2024. If you do not have a fall housing assignment, your 13-week summer stay is over on August 2, 2024, which is your checkout deadline. **This date is not flexible**, so please plan ahead!
