Each MSW student is required to take 2 electives over the course of their program. As a clinical specialization student pursuing the embedded PPSC, you will utilize your two electives to take two core PPSC courses, SOCW 563 - School Social Work and SOCW 540 - Educational Policy

**SOCW 563 must be taken in the Fall of Year 2 with your specialization practicum at a school site. This results in 12 units of enrollment (full time) in Fall of Year 2

You may take additional electives if you wish, but it will be outside of the 36 units required to graduate.
