Electives

Each MSW student is required to take 2 electives over the course of their program. As a clinical specialization student pursuing the embedded PPSC, you will utilize your two electives to take two core PPSC courses, SOCW 563 - School Social Work and SOCW 540 - Educational Policy

*SOCW 540 can be taken over the summer or in the Spring of Year 2 *SOCW 563 must be taken in the Fall of Year 2 with your specialization practicum at a school site.

You may take additional electives if you wish, but it will be outside of the 60 units required to graduate.

A total of 60 units is required for graduation, but your degree can be up to 66 units and still qualify for financial aid
