Who can join Sigma as a student?

- Upper 35% of class
- Academic integrity

Graduate students (Masters & Doctoral):

- Completion of 1/4 of the nursing curriculum;
- ❖ Cumulative GPA ≥ 3.5
- Academic integrity
- All graduate students may be inducted as a Nurse Leader

Who can join Sigma as a Nurse Leader?

- Legally recognized to practice in their country.
- Minimum of a baccalaureate degree or the equivalent in any field.
- Demonstrates achievement in nursing.
- Any graduate student can apply in this category.
