Keynote Speaker: Helen De Cruz, Ph.D.

Dr. De Cruz will examine the perceived conflict contemporary American Christians feel between their faith and accepted scientific facts, about evolution, geology and other topics. She will empirical evidence on perceived conflict between science and religion among American Christians, including stereotype threat, disinterest, and negative perceptions about science. By analyzing this perceived conflict, Dr. De Cruz hopes to shed light on whether, and how, successful integration between science and religion in the public sphere can take place.
