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Profile

Kathleen Fletcher Bacer is a Professor and creator/director of APU's Online Master of Arts in Educational Technology program and directs the Master of Arts in Education: Learning & Technology program. Her expertise stems from 19 years of K-8 public school classroom teaching and 23+ years training teachers in educational technology, classroom management, and manipulative math techniques. Bacer's current fundamental interests and teaching revolve around training teachers how to effectively embrace and utilize technology in the K-12 classroom, thus empowering the construction of knowledge. Her teaching models a belief that 'critical to any teaching/learning process is the ability to effectively connect with the learner to enable them to transform the instructional delivery system into a personal educational experience.' (Bacer, K. 2002) Her research and leadership spans connecting effective teaching pedagogy to diverse learning styles, implementation of emergent technologies, nurturing and sustaining dynamic online learning communities and promoting cross-cultural classrooms through global learning telecollaborative projects. Known for her innovative and creative techniques, she has created a model for effective online learning environments with multi-dimensional designs and has developed numerous manipulative math techniques and classroom management strategies for teachers to utilize in the classroom.
